- 3. How does Solomon sum up all that he has seen and said (vv.13-14)?

APPLYING GOD'S WORD

- 1. Does the conclusion of verses 13-14 encourage or discourage thoughtful planning in life, having and pursuing dreams, and enjoying rest and/or leisure?
- 2. Why do you think wisdom is often so hard to hear and follow?
- 3. Is there ever a time when a pursuit of wisdom could actually be to our detriment (consider verse 12)? If so, how or why?

PRAYING GOD'S WORD

- 1. Father, help us to treasure wisdom from above, and to order our lives around what you provide.
- 2. Guard our hearts from worthless pursuit of things that project themselves as wisdom but don't have their roots firmly established in you.
- 3. Teach us to fear you above all else, and trust you completely.
