

DISCUSSING GOD'S WORD

- 1. How does wisdom lead us to relate to God-appointed authorities (see also Romans 13:1-7)?
- 2. What truths in this chapter shatter our certainty regarding the future (on this earth) and our illusion of control?
- 3. How does an accurate perception of the future (and of eternity) impact our choices now according to verses 10-13?
- 4. Despite the things we can't know, what does God want us to enjoy in this life (verses 14-17)? What does that tell us about the character of our God?

APPLYING GOD'S WORD

- 1. In our divided political age, how can this chapter help us to "Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor" (1 Peter 2:17)?
- 2. Has a desire to "find out" how something will play out "under the sun" (a business venture, a relationship, a move, etc.) created a weariness in your heart? How can you seek joy in God and the gifts He has given even if you never "find it out?"
- 3. How can you graciously and winsomely help someone in your sphere of influence recognize the reality of coming judgment (v. 11-13) and the offer of refuge in Jesus Christ?

- 1. Father in heaven, please fill our hearts with Spirit-given wisdom and insight that we might walk in a manner worthy of You.
- 2. God, please make us a community of people who fear You and enjoy the gifts You give in a way that helps us enjoy You, the giver, more and more.
