DISCUSS GOD'S WORD

1. What is something that you look forward to every year?
2. Verse 23 indicates that Christians look forward to Jesus' second coming by pursuing blamelessness. What do you think this means? How do you define the word blameless?
3. Does blameless mean perfect? Why or why not?
4. Verses 23-24 points us to trust God with our sanctification as we wait for Christ. Is anyone currently discouraged by sin in their life? Pray for one another as a group to entrust their spiritual growth to God.
5. People of the kingdom pray for one another (verse 25). When was a time in your life when someone else's prayers greatly encouraged or affected you?
6. People of the kingdom feed on God's word with one another (verse 27). As a group, how can we point one another to the Bible more?
7. People of the kingdom extend God's grace to one another (verse 28). In what ways have you seen Christ's death and resurrection on display in our group? Has anyone been a picture of Christ for you?
